

NeemLeaf

A versatile botanical from Ayurvedic medicine

Neem (*Azadirachta indica*) is among the cornerstone botanicals in Ayurvedic medicine, with a history dating back several thousand years. Neem leaf is regarded as a panacea (cure-all) throughout India, with applications ranging from its use in toothpaste for cavity prevention to the treatment of serious bacterial, viral, fungal, and parasitic infections.

The many uses of neem leaf in Ayurvedic medicine include the treatment of skin conditions such as eczema, relief from fever, treatment of itching from skin disorders, and as a digestive aid.

New Roots Herbal's **Neem**Leaf contains over 50 volatile compounds that exert powerful therapeutic and antioxidant benefits. With recent knowledge and methods for quantifying disease prevention potential, the ORAC (oxygen radical absorbance capacity) value of neem has been determined to be 5 times greater than blueberries, and 20 times that of broccoli and grapefruit.

In joint studies conducted between the Howard University College of Medicine and the University of Nigeria, neem leaf was shown effective in the treatment of malaria, cancer, and HIV. Sulfides and polysaccharides found in neem leaf have been found effective for both antifungal and anti-inflammatory applications. Studies have also shown neem leaf to bolster populations of CD4⁺ T cells in AIDS patients. CD4⁺ cells play an integral role for immune response, as they initiate the body's response to infection. Recent studies at the University of Madras have also shown promise for the administration of ethanolic neem extracts for causing the death (apoptosis) of prostate cancer cells.
